We are very excited to offer for the first time the Camp Saw Mill Counselor in Training program! This fun, challenging learning experience is definitely different from being a camper!

Our purpose is to help you build skills and experience to prepare you to be a future camp counselor. We want to help you learn and gain expertise in leadership, program planning and implementation and working with children. We anticipate someday you may decide to apply for a position as a **Camp Saw Mill** staff member and, as a CIT graduate, you would bring strong training and experience! Part of your training begins today with the CIT application. Applicants must be 13 or 14 years old.

In addition to this letter, our CIT material contains an application and a form for you to give to two references who can speak to your leadership skills, work experience, academic work and/or work with children. The application form is to be filled out by the applicant only. Camp Saw Mill CIT Program will be based on selection only.

The CIT application serves two purposes:

1. Provides us insight as to why you want to be a CIT and highlights experience you may have.
2. Helps to determine if the CIT program is a good fit for both of us since we accept a limited number of CITs.

After you complete and return the application and we receive your two CIT references, we will contact you by telephone to set up an interview. We have questions we would like to ask you, information to share with you about the CIT program and we want to give you an opportunity to ask us questions.

Being a Camp Saw Mill CIT is a unique opportunity – it includes more privileges than campers have and more responsibilities! We hope you will be part of our 2010 CIT group!
